Health Canada's Safe Environments Programme (SEP) 2001-on, expanded into **the Chemicals Management Plan (CMP)** in 2006. It is a Government of Canada initiative aimed at reducing the risks posed by chemicals to Canadians and their environment. To date, the program has addressed 3,621 of the 4,300 chemicals identified as priorities for attention by 2020–2021, including draft and final assessments; has found 456 existing chemicals to be harmful to the environment and/or human health; and has implemented over 90 risk management actions for existing chemicals. Additional tools are in development.
